However it could be presumed that a quick return would raise some eyebrows and I'm not sure I could say what (if any) action would be taken.

In regards to your commitment to the Falcons, it really does depend on what you've signed. We've actually come across two similar situations this year where players refused to continue paying and demanded to be released from their agreements with the club. Now, in our case, we were able to show that we had given the players in question sufficient time to make a decision as to whether they would join (3 weeks training for free), also known as a "Cooling-off period". We also proved that our Terms were in "plain and simple English", openly disclosing the full amount a player owed the club and the terms of cancellation. But this is only how we protect ourselves and I can't comment on the Falcon's Terms, having never seen them.

My advice would be to read through your contract and, if needed, get a second opinion from someone independent to avoid conflicts of interest. Then discuss options with the Falcons if you still wish to transfer. BAFA do offer a mediation service if you can't come to an agreement (£25 from both teams). Final bit of advice, talk to them sooner rather than later. It's much harder to come to a mutual agreement the further down the line you go.
